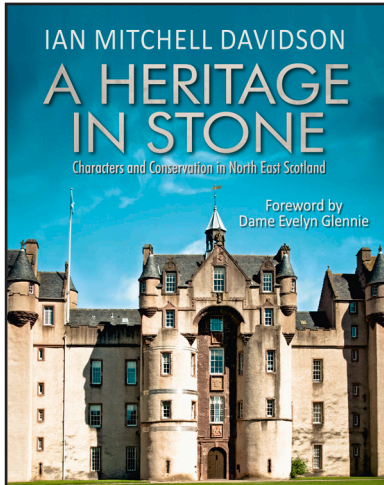

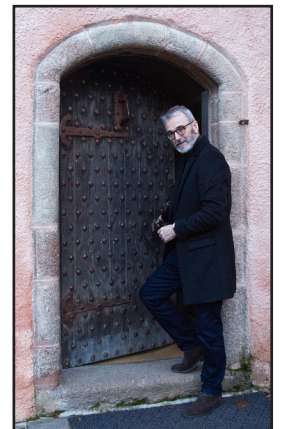

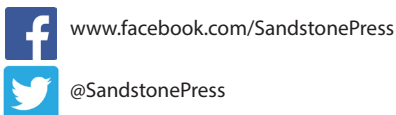
ABOUT THE AUTHOR
