

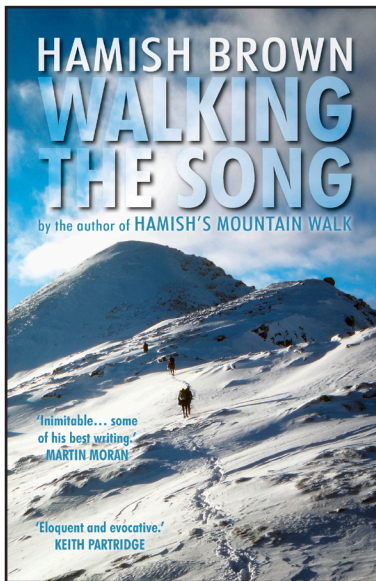

ABOUT THIS BOOK

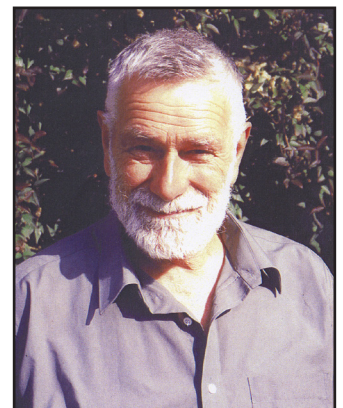
