

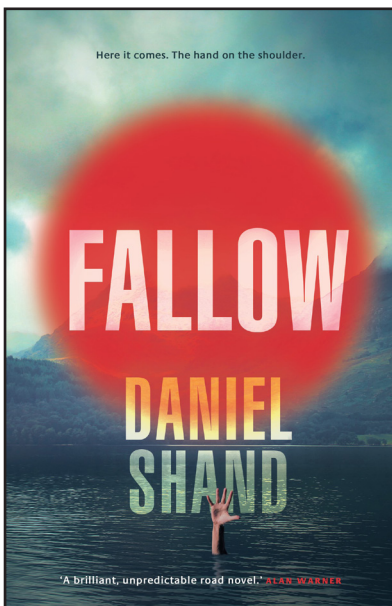

At the heart of this tense and at times times darkly comic novel is the relationship between two brothers bound by a terrible crime.
