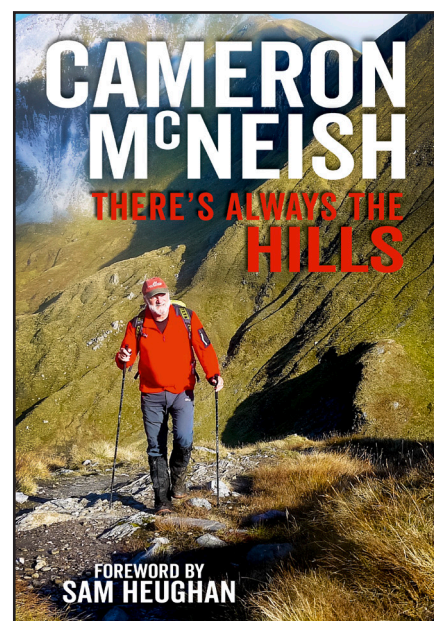
THE FOREWORD AUTHOR
